

## **MythoSelf™ Facilitator's and Trainer's Code of Conduct:**

The MythoSelf™ Facilitator's and Trainer's Code of Conduct sets forth the principals of conduct that are required of and agreed to by all Licensed Certified MythoSelf™ Facilitators and Trainers. The essence of the MythoSelf™ Facilitator's and Trainer's Code of Conduct is extremely simple:

***“Do the right thing ... always.”***

### **Where the Process Begins**

The MythoSelf™ Facilitator's and Trainer's Code of Conduct begins within each Licensed Certified MythoSelf™ Facilitator and Trainer, in their personal integrity and commitment to this work. Every client seeking facilitating and/or training in the MythoSelf™ Process is presumed to be seeking to improve their own quality of life and the quality of life of those around them. Clients expect and deserve to work with a professional who is as committed as they are to their personal and professional development and success learning, applying and using the MythoSelf™ Process for themselves and with others.

The MythoSelf™ Facilitator's Certification Process and the MythoSelf™ Trainer's Certification Process are among the most rigorous and demanding required for any professional in personal and/or professional development. Each Licensed Certified MythoSelf™ Facilitator and Trainer have committed themselves to training, individual private mentoring, peer review and evaluation, and on-going professional education. Only those individuals completing the entire certification process including training, mentoring and peer review who are then recommended by both their Licensed MythoSelf™ Mentoring Trainer and a Licensed MythoSelf™ Third-Party Reviewing Trainer and agree to abide at all times to the MythoSelf™ Facilitator's and Trainer's Code of Conduct are invited to join the community of Licensed MythoSelf™ Professionals themselves.

## **The Process Continues**

The study of the MythoSelf™ Process is a life long commitment, which is distinguished by commitment, continual learning and personal development. Licensed Certified MythoSelf™ Facilitators and Trainers are committed to continually improving their understanding of the Process and refining their use of the Process for themselves and with their clients. This begins with the adoption and the application of the MythoSelf™ Process in their own lives and then extends beyond themselves to the knowledge, skills and experience they develop in working with clients. The most essential aspect is impeccable “INTENT” – a focused personal awareness and direction of attention and action along a path that fits and matches for them without compromise.

MythoSelf™ Facilitator and Trainer Candidates are continually evaluated during the certification process for their readiness to join the community of Licensed MythoSelf™ professionals. MythoSelf™ Facilitator and Trainer Candidates must be of good character, have a clear sense of personal integrity, unyielding commitment to the work, a deepening understanding of the concepts and principles of the MythoSelf™ Process as well as the knowledge and skills to apply the work to their own lives and with clients. Facilitators and Trainers must have the knowledge and skills to convey these concepts and principles to clients in the application of the MythoSelf™ Process with them. This is especially true of Trainers who are in a legacy role and in addition to working with individual clients and groups own the responsibility of developing the next generation of Licensed MythoSelf™ professionals.

### **I. Principals of Conduct Within the Process:**

A Licensed Certified MythoSelf™ Facilitator/Trainer has the responsibility of demonstrating the qualities of integrity, commitment and respect in their interactions with peers, colleagues and clients. These qualities are demonstrated within these interactions by sustaining the space held when working with clients even when these clients cannot hold this space for themselves. These qualities are also demonstrated within interactions with peers and colleagues by remaining open to learning from and sharing learning with others, those more and less experienced than themselves.

- A. It is the responsibility of the Licensed MythoSelf™ Facilitator/Trainer to maintain a professional attitude throughout the period of time during which the Facilitator/Trainer is working with clients and/or interacting with peers and colleagues.
- B. MythoSelf™ Facilitators and Trainers do not use their position for hidden gain, whether that gain be personal, professional, financial, emotional, or political or in nature. MythoSelf™ Facilitators and Trainers do not enter into sexual relationships with clients while they are working with them as clients.
- C. Clients retain the right of confidentiality, and no private information of a client's is ever released to a third party without the prior consent of the client without a formal written warrant or court order, including but not limited to other MythoSelf™ Facilitators and/or Trainers.
- D. While the application of the MythoSelf™ Process may produce effects that are beneficial or therapeutic, a MythoSelf™ Facilitator/Trainer informs any and all clients that the MythoSelf™ Process is an educational process, which improves the general sense of wellbeing, personal alignment and integrity, level of structural and functional wellformedness, personal readiness and the ability to interact with others successfully. In cases where professional medical and/or psychological assistance is indicated, MythoSelf™ Facilitators and Trainers encourage their students to seek such help. At no time does a MythoSelf™ Facilitator/Trainer make medical or psychological diagnoses or prescribe medical or psychological remedies. A MythoSelf™ Facilitator/Trainer does not proffer claims that the MythoSelf™ Process is a cure for any malady.
- E. Any policy regarding payment, cancellation, lateness or proper interaction is fully explained to the student prior to the commencement of facilitation and/or training and if necessary at the discretion of the Facilitator/Trainer put in writing.

- F. MythoSelf™ Process training does not require any special props or clothing, and at no time is there a requirement for or during the Process to disrobe. Special projects requiring special dress are to be explained and agreed upon beforehand by all participants.
- G. Clients have the right to register a formal violation of the Code of Conduct complaint with the Board of Licensed MythoSelf™ Trainers. Their Facilitator/Trainer informs them of the process for doing so.

## **II. Knowledge Within the Process**

- A. Demonstrate an embodied understanding of the MythoSelf™ Process concepts and principles in their own lives by consciously allowing a positive change in their own general sense of wellbeing, personal alignment and integrity, level of structural and functional well-formedness, personal readiness and the ability to interact with others successfully; and to continue this change throughout every activity and interaction in order to improve the quality of their way of being in the world and personal/professional performance. This positive change can be observed as 1) an impeccable integrity evident in all their personal and professional interactions; 2) an enhanced alertness, awareness, attention, directionality and personal elegance; 3) and obvious commitment to the work noticeable in their orientation to the excitatory bias as they move through the world on their own and interact with others.
- B. Demonstrate a knowledge of the MythoSelf™ Process by engaging in discussions, exchange of knowledge, ideas and concepts and their own understanding of the Process and how their commitment to the MythoSelf™ Process in their own lives have influenced their development as persons and as Facilitators/Trainers; and suggest what activity they would recommend to a client and why.

- C. Demonstrate an understanding of essential concepts and principals of the MythoSelf™ Process as they relate to personal and professional development education and training; be able to help clients understand how applying the concepts of accessing and operating from the Excitatory Bias, G.D.S., G.T.S., operating along the Trajectory of INTENT, building, holding and operating in relation to the Teleological Projection, and establishing and operating from the Ready State impacts and improves the quality of their life and the quality of the lives of those around them and when appropriate refer them to other sources for more detailed input and/or answers.
- D. Demonstrate a thorough understanding of the MythoSelf™ Facilitator's and Trainer's Code of Conduct, have an appreciation of the professional issues that apply in working with clients, and know when it is appropriate to refer a client to another professional.

### **III. Skills Within the Process**

- A. Demonstrate an ability to clearly and simply communicate and demonstrate the concepts and principles of the MythoSelf™ Process by giving clear demonstrations and verbal explanations that are appropriate to the client's learning; when using both verbal and non-verbal techniques to do so with sensitivity and appropriately.
- B. Demonstrate an ability to establish rapport and elicit information conversationally in relation to doing the work with clients.
- C. Demonstrate an ability to use Somatic Micro-Calibration in tracking and adumbrating client states.
- D. Demonstrating a thorough understanding and ability to apply hypnotic protocols as appropriate, both verbal and non-verbal.
- E. Demonstrate an ability to access G.D.S./G.T.S. and build the oscillation of INTENT.
- F. Demonstrate an ability to identify the Trajectory of INTENT and build directionality in relation to the Teleological Projection.
- G. Demonstrate a thorough understanding of the Soma-Semantic Form as well as the Mythic Form.

- H. Demonstrate an ability to elicit the description of the client's Mythic Form and feed it back to the client.
- I. Demonstrate an ability to use D.T.I. to install the Mythic Form.
- J. For Trainers, demonstrating an ability in identifying the Topological Form and being able to work directly with it.
- K. For Trainers, demonstrating an ability to explain, demonstrate and teach the essential form of the MythoSelf™ Process.
- L. For Trainers, demonstrating an ability to observe themselves while teaching, and later articulate to an observer the choices they made with regard to calibration, adumbration, verbal explanations, modeling and demonstrations.

#### **IV. Formal Complaints of Violation of Code of Conduct**

The following information is intended to clarify the formal procedure for filing a complaint of violation of the MythoSelf™ Facilitator's and Trainer's Code of Conduct.

We believe that by making this process clear and explicit, we best serve the community of Licensed MythoSelf™ professionals, clients of Licensed MythoSelf™ professionals and the general public.

Before presenting a complaint it is important to consider the following:

1. Do you wish to proceed with your grievance knowing that the person complained against will be informed?
2. Do you understand that the person complained against will see your grievance in its entirety?

[NOTE: In no way are these questions intended to dissuade a complainant, but to assure all persons involved that the MythoSelf™ complaint process is consistent and fair.]

If the answer to both of the questions above is 'yes', and you decide to proceed, the Board of Licensed MythoSelf™ Trainers will convene a Board of Trainers specifically to review and address the complaint.

- a) Their own full name, address and telephone number where they can be reached as the complainant
- b) The name of the Facilitator/Trainer at whom the complaint is directed, date(s), location and context, e.g.: private MythoSelf™ Process work, MythoSelf™ Process training, where the violation occurred
- c) The nature of the violation in the words of the complainant
- d) Any additional information regarding the violation and/or Facilitator/Trainer that the complainant thinks the Board of Trainers will need or want to know to properly review and address the complaint

The Board of Trainers convened to review and address the complaint will:

- e) Send a copy of the complaint to the person named in the complaint along with an explanatory letter as to how they should proceed.
- f) Send copies of the complaint to the Chairman of the Board of Licensed MythoSelf™ Trainers.
- g) If the answer to either of these questions is 'no', the complainant may re-write the complaint in such a way that they can allow it to be read by the person complained against. Or, they may decide not to send the complaint.

[NOTE: All formal complaints must be submitted to the Board of Trainers/Ethics, P.O. Box 26, Ridgewood, NJ 07451, USA by registered mail, preferably in typewritten form.]

If the complainant has contacted the Board of Licensed MythoSelf™ Trainers and/or the Chairman but chooses not to proceed further with their complaint they will inform the Board of Trainers convened to review and address the complaint of their decision immediately.

Once these procedures have been followed, and the complaint proceeds, the Board of Trainers will:

- a) Hold all information in strict confidence.
- b) Inform the person against whom the complaint is lodged the full extent of the complaint and request a reply in writing by registered mail.
- c) Review all material submitted and work toward a decision.
- d) Once the complaint has been dealt with all parties involved will be:
  - i. Notified by registered mail the conclusions reached by the Board of Trainers.
  - ii. Upon request all original materials will be returned.
  - iii. All original materials not requested for return and all copies held by the Board of Trainers will be destroyed.

[NOTE: No Licensed Certified MythoSelf™ Facilitator/Trainer is above or beyond the procedure for filing formal complaints of violations of the Code of Conduct. Any and all formal complaints will cause a Board of Trainers to be convened to review and address the complaint, all complaints will be fully reviewed and addressed by the Board of Trainers, a conclusion will be reached within a reasonable time frame. Clear and egregious violations of the Code of Conduct can result in immediate loss of licensure. Less serious infractions will result in no less than a permanent record in the file of the Facilitator/Trainer and potential additional disciplinary action. If the violation is deemed unwarranted it will be dismissed and no record will result from the complaint. Regardless of the conclusion reached by the Board of Trainers and the Chairman all parties involved will be informed. All records of the proceedings of the Board of Trainers and the Chairman in reviewing and addressing the complaint will be destroyed or kept permanently sealed.]
